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Changes in MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.7 (Not yet released, LTS Release)

Version 8.4.7 has no release notes, or they have not been published because the product version has not been released.

Changes in MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.6 (2025-07-22, LTS Release)

MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.6 is the latest release for the MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4 LTS series. It supports MySQL Server 8.4.6.

Bugs Fixed

- When a TTS image backup taken with full-locking was restored by streaming the image to `mysqlbackup`, the restore failed due to a tail magic mismatch. (Bug #37196546)
- After a backup was finished, the values of the server's status variables `Com_stmt_prepare` and `Com_stmt_close` did not match. It was because `mysqlbackup`, after using prepared statements to query the server, closed its connection to the server prematurely. With this fix, `Com_stmt_close` is also incremented before `mysqlbackup` disconnects from the server. (Bug #34624351)

MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.5 is the latest release for the MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4 LTS series. It supports MySQL Server 8.4.5.

Bugs Fixed

- The Windows executable for MySQL Enterprise Backup listed the wrong product name under its Properties. (Bug #36510981)

Changes in MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.0 (2024-04-30, LTS Release)

MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.0 marks the start of a new series of LTS (Long Term Support) releases. MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.0 is recommended for use on production systems.

The 8.4.X LTS releases focus on security and bug fixes while the next Innovation series includes new features.

MySQL Enterprise Backup 8.4.0 supports MySQL Server 8.4 only. For earlier versions of MySQL, use the MySQL Enterprise Backup version with the same version number as the server.

Functionality Added or Changed

- Because the [keyring_file](#) and [keyring_encrypted_file](#) plugins have been removed from MySQL Enterprise Server 8.4.0, when backups with encrypted InnoDB tables of a server using any keyring plugins are restored, the server is now going to start with [component_keyring_encrypted_file](#), unless a [keyring migration](#) has been performed on the restored server. See [Working with Encrypted InnoDB Tablespace](#) for details. (WL #16012)

Bugs Fixed

- Compression ratio was low for compressed backups created by release 8.0.34 and later, comparing with earlier versions of MySQL Enterprise Backup. (Bug #36021808)
- Backup operations failed for a server that had the Performance Schema turned off. (Bug #34595073)

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
